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Pregnancy Medication List

Over the Counter Medications that you can take while Pregnant

In the first three months of pregnancy, you should try to avoid taking any Medications (prescriptions or over the counter) unless first checking with the doctor.

NAUSEA AND VOMITING:

General Treatment:

- Rise slowly in the morning
- Eat a few crackers at bedtime & before rising in the morning
- Avoid greasy, spicy foods; eat more frequently, but smaller portions

Medical Treatment: *Emetrol *Nestrex *Ginger *Vitamin B Complex (Stop prenatal vitamins or iron for a few days)

DIARRHEA:

General Treatment:

- Drink plenty of fluids (i.e.- Gatorade, Sprite, 7-up); avoid dairy (except yogurt, consume 1 yogurt container daily) and citrus juices (i.e. – orange, grapefruit)

Medical Treatment: *Imodium AD *Kaopectate *Probiotics

CONSTIPATION AND LAXATIVES:

General Treatment:

- Stop iron tablets for a few days
- Eat more bulk or bran, fresh fruits and vegetables

Medical Treatment:*Metamucil *Dulcolax *Citrucel *Fibercon *Fiberchoice *Miralax
*Konsyl *Senekot *Colace *Milk of Magnesia *Peri-colace *Doxidan

HEARTBURN AND INDIGESTION:

General Treatment:

- Eat more frequent, but smaller meals
- Do not lay flat, prop your head up
- Do not go to bed immediately after eating

Medical Treatment:*Liquid antacids work better than tablets *Riopan *Mylanta II *Prevacid
*Maalox *Tums *Rolaids *Zantac *Gaviscon *Pepcid *Prilosec

HEADACHES AND MILD PAIN:

- 2 Extra Strength Tylenol every 4 hours as needed (avoid aspirin and ibuprofen)

CONGESTION:

General Treatment:

- Humidifier, rest, fluids, Neti pot

Medical Treatment: *Saline Nasal Spray *Drixoral *Claritin *Tylenol & Tylenol PM
*Robitussin & Robitussin DM: **Avoid these Medication with
pseudoephedrine if you have high blood pressure: *Sudafed *Actifed
*Dimatap *Tylenol cold or Sinus**

HEMORRHOIDS:

General Treatment: Avoid constipation and straining with bowel movements

Medical Treatment: *Anusol HC *Preparation H *Proctofoam *Proctocream
